

## **They Shall Be Like Dew | Micah 5:2-15**

---

**Summary:** In Micah 5:2-15, when the Messiah is born, He will lead His people to victory over their enemies and use them to bring blessing to the world.

**1. The Messiah will lead His people to victory over their enemies. (v. 5-6)**

- See Romans 16:20; Revelation 12:10–12; Matthew 16:18; 1 Corinthians 15:25–26

**2. The Messiah will send His people into the world to bring blessing to the world. (v. 7-9)**

- See Genesis 12:3; Galatians 3:7–9; 2 Corinthians 2:14–17; Philippians 1:27–30; Philippians 3:18–21; 2 Corinthians 10:3–6; Romans 12:21

**3. The Messiah's people will be a holy people who depend on the Lord, not their own resources, as they fulfill their mission. (v. 10-14)**

- See Psalm 20:7

**4. In the end, the Lord will execute vengeance on those who do not obey. (v. 15)**

- See 2 Thessalonians 1:5–9

**Two Challenges:**

**1) We need to revisit what it means to be a Christian.**

- See Romans 10:9; Colossians 2:6; Colossians 3-4

**2) We need to rely on the Lord, not on our own resources.**

- See Colossians 1:10–11; Mark 9:28–29
